MEET CUTE

Each person picks 3 unrelated words from the menu (or just use cocktail names) and the other person has to create a character based on those words. How do they meet in a ridiculous way? Does it work out?

MEET CUTE IMPOSSIBLE

Imagine 3 ways the two characters are so different that their love is both impossible & a terrible idea (e.g. one lives in the sky, the other at the bottom of the sea). Describe their first few dates, then epilogue—does it work out? Inspired by Alex Roberts' awesome Star Crossed.
